

WLS Three-Year Intensive Supplies used-to-date—Start of Year 2

- 4 beanbags—2 blue, 2 red
- 2 wool (or blend) yarn skeins—1 blue, 1 red
- 2 wool (or blend) yarn balls—1 blue, 1 red
- 2 beeswax balls—1 blue, 1 red
- 2 bouncing balls (6-8"/15-20cm)—1 blue, 1 red
- Masking tape (take to use type that will not harm your furniture)
- 2 copper balls (or similar)
- 1 soft ball (5-6"/13-15cm) to hold in feet for copper ball exercise (can be playground-type, needle felted, cloth, or similar)
- Copper rod(s) for your size & student's
- Tennis balls (3) or similar
- Soft lead pencils (2B or similar)
- Full set* of colored pencils
- Full set* of *block* crayons
- Full set* of *stick* crayons
- At least 3 old *stick* crayons (for scribble exercise)
- Forms--3 fold spiral, dominance form,
- 8.5x11"/A4 white paper
- 11x17"/A3 white paper
- Watercolor paper 12x18"/30x46cm (approximately)
- Large paper for I 8 exercise (roll 18"-24"/45-60cm wide white paper suggested—20# bond is adequate—example: <https://www.amazon.com/Alliance-Untaped-Paper-Bright-Engineering/dp/B00GMNZM0W?th=1> or www.freedompaper.com their website is under construction).
- Chalkboard surface or large paper to put onto wall
- Clay cubes (note: Audrey McAllen specified clay; alternative: beeswax cubes—blue & red)
- Marbles—at least 2
- Paints—see list attached separately
- Soft/comfortable surface for developmental movements (or mat)

Assessment: (many already listed above)

- 4 beanbags—2 blue, 2 red
- 8.5x11"/A4 white paper
- 11x17"/A3 white paper
- 11x17"/A3 white paper cut into 3 long strips per piece of paper
- Full set* of stick crayons
- Full set* of colored pencils
- Eye tracking tool (can be yarn tied to a pen or similar)
- Simple dominance tools—shells 2, scopes 2
- Soft/comfortable surface for developmental movements (or mat)
- Handedness pattern forms (for under 10 years) including red circle
- Your working form for recording your observations (you will keep refining it as we go—share with us if you want feedback)

*Full set of colors (as listed or similar): 2 reds—carmine & vermillion, orange, 2 yellows—golden & lemon, 3 greens—yellow-green, green, blue-green, 2 blues—ultramarine & cobalt, 2 violets—blue-violet & red-violet/magenta, pink, peach, 3 browns—yellow-brown, red-brown, brown (dark), black. [Additional colors OK to include: white, Prussian blue, dark green, gold, silver, etc.]
